Last year brought a mammoth change to the centre, as we came to the realisation that the only way to really make a difference and give our kids a positive future was through education. At the beginning of 2010 we began the transformation and started an education enrichment programme. Each child commits to attend their own school in the morning and have extra classes in English and maths at the centre in the afternoon. We finished the year with 120 dedicated students and the changes in their school reports have been amazing!

Word has spread through the community and we are starting 2011 with 170 children and a waiting list.
